## What are the JFCNO ?

Les Jeux franco-canadien du Nord et de l'Ouest (JFCNO), or the Northwestern Francophone Games, is a gathering dedicated to French-speaking youth between the ages of 14 and 18, living in the northern and western provinces of Canada (Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, Nunavut, Northwest Territories, Saskatchewan and Yukon).

This five day event full of unique experiences will strengthen the cultural identity of these young francophones with many opportunities to meet and engage with new friends !

The JFCNO are a **non-competitive** event that will focus on building relationships between French-speaking youth aged 14 to 18 from across the Western provinces and the territories. Its objective is to offer stimulating and diverse programming for French-speaking youth that will help them create resilience to the ever-changing world that surrounds them, especially after several years of isolation, lack of support in French and increased mental health awareness.

There are **3 Profiles, 12 Events**:

- **Arts:** Culinary Arts, Visual Arts, Improvisation, Music
- **Leadership:** Community engagement, Public Speaking, Media
- **Sports:** Badminton, Basketball, Running, Ultimate Frisbee, Volleyball

## JFCNO are not JeuxFC

The 2020 Victoria Games (JeuxFC) is the local host committee which was created to organize the 8th edition of the Canadian Francophone Games in July 2020. These Games are owned by the national partner, the Fédération jeunesse canadienne-française (FJCF) of which Association jeunesse fransaskoise (AJF) is a member. In December 2021, the FJCF canceled the Victoria 2020 Games due to the pandemic and began their process to organize and plan the next edition in 2025.



## The JFCNO are a completely different and unique project!

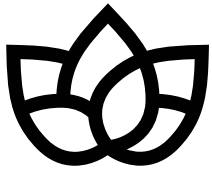
The teams will be **mixed** between the provinces and territories and will be formed on the spot when in Victoria. By being part of the Saskatchewan delegation, participants will represent Saskatchewan, but will be part of a mixed team with members from other provinces or territories.

For Example: An improv team of 6 kids could be made up of 2 from Saskatchewan, 1 from Yukon, and 3 from Manitoba. This mixed team will work together for training and improv tournaments.

It's the same for all disciplines – even in sports! Experience levels will vary, but the goal is to meet, work together and create something new.



# ASSOCIATION JEUNESSE FRANSASKOISE



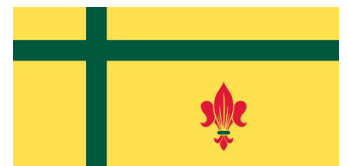

The **Association jeunesse fransaskoise (AJF)** is a non-profit organization that works in the youth sector in French throughout Saskatchewan! The organization sets up activities in French youth between the ages of 12 and 25. It costs nothing to be a member. Our goal is to introduce and bring to life the Fransaskois culture to young people in Saskatchewan through sports, cultural activities and leadership training.

The AJF relies on dynamic youth who like to have fun and get involved so that they can continue to serve the community. The goal of the AJF is to reach as many youth as possible, and we know that it is not always easy to ensure full payment for an activity. We can therefore make arrangements if a financial constraint prevents a person from participating in an activity. All you have to do is contact the general manager to discuss the solutions that can be offered to them. The Association jeunesse fransaskoise is here made by and for youth!

## **AJF's role at the JFCNO**

The AJF is the organizing body for Team Saskatchewan. The AJF recruits the team, organizes transportation and chaperones the event. The **AJF will coordinate transportation to Victoria from Saskatoon for the JFCNO**. The cost of transportation is included in your registration cost.







# EVENTS AND DISCIPLINES

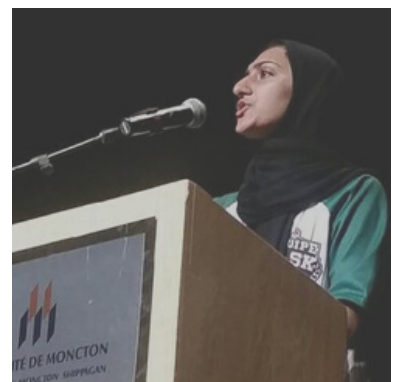
## Art events

- Culinary Arts: 2 spots per delegation
- Visual Arts: 6 spots per delegation
- Improvisation: 6 spots per delegation
- Music: one solo artist or band per delegation (from 1 to 6 people maximum)



## Leadership events

- Community Engagement: 4 spots per delegation
- Public Speaking: 2 spots per delegation
- Media: 4 spots per delegation



## Sport events

- Badminton: 6 spots per delegation
- Basketball: 5 spots per delegation
- Running: 10 spots per delegation
- Ultimate frisbee: 10 spots per delegation
- Volleyball: 6 spots per delegation

## During the day

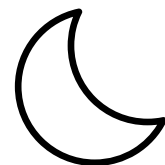
Participants will meet with their new team of mixed province and territory members and challenge each other in their own discipline.
